
Subclass 457 Visa Reforms

On 18 March 2015, the Government responded on the recommendations submitted in the report, entitled, Robust New Foundations - A streamlined Transparent and Responsive System for the 457 Programme.

The review identified opportunities to enhance several aspects of the programme to improve the Subclass 457 Visa programme's flexibility which is great news for 457 sponsors and applicants of ISA Group.

Implementation of the review's recommendation has begun and will be further rolled out throughout 2015. These reforms will simplify the Subclass 457 Visa programme, reduce red tape, strengthen integrity, prevent abuse and protect Australian workers.

Majority of the reforms to the Subclass 457 Visa programme will be progressed before the end of 2015-16.

Introduction of changes by VETASSESS

There will be limited number of places left for the Skilled Nominated category for 2014-2015 Migration programme, leading to longer processing times. Once the remaining places are used, the Department will no longer grant visas in this


