



## **Receival Point Operator – Bulk Materials Handling Officer Immediate vacancies – Western Australia**

### **POSITION SUMMARY**

Receive, store and out-load all grains within the storage system. Assist, operate and maintain storage facilities.

### **DUTIES:**

- Prepare grain storages for filling (i.e. cleaning )
- Fill grain storages either by monitoring grain flows onto a grid, or by usage of portable or fixed machinery.
- Check grain flow for quality requirements on all movements of grain.
- Maintain storages and surrounds in a hygienic condition (i.e. sweeping, blowing, using air lances, brooms & other equipment)
- Assist with the out-loading of grain using either rail wagons or road trucks.
- Assist in the tarping of grain stacks.

### **PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT/REQUIREMENTS**

In order to carry out the duties as designated, you will be required to:

- Bend, stretch, lift, carry and climb
- Stand for long periods.
- Work at heights above ground level with use of safety equipment
- Walk along steel mesh walkways with side rails above ground level (up to 30metres)
- Work in confined spaces
- Work in areas with high grain dust concentrations (respiratory & eye protection available)
- Work exposed to outside elements
- Comply with company Sun Protection and Heat Stress Workplace Health and Safety Standards - this means all staff will be required to wear long sleeved shirts and long pants at all times. Stout leather footwear is also required to be worn by all staff.
